Starling in North Queensland.—Looking through my diary of a visit to North Queensland during 1944, I came upon this record which has not previously been published—“European Starling; one noted at Port Douglas, November 10, 1944—an unusual sight, as I haven’t seen one before in North Queensland.” Port Douglas was then (and probably is still) a semi-derelict coastal town between Cairns and Mossman, the stepping-off place for Low Island and its mangrove-covered satellite, Woody Island, where there is a breeding colony of the Torres Strait (Nutmeg) Pigeon (*Myristicivora spilorrhoea*). Has the Starling (*Sturnus vulgaris*) been noted so far north since then?—MICHAEL SHARLAND, Hobart, Tas., 28/8/52.
