The XVIth International Ornithological Congress was held in Canberra, ACT, Australia from 12 to 17 August 1974. It was under the patronage of HRH The Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, KG, KT, and was sponsored by the Australian Academy of Science and the Royal Australasian Ornithologists Union. Prof. J. Dorst of the Museum National d'Histoire Naturelle, Paris, France, was President and Dr H. J. Frith, CSIRO, Division of Wildlife Research, Canberra, ACT, was Secretary-General.

Total membership of the Congress was 807.
