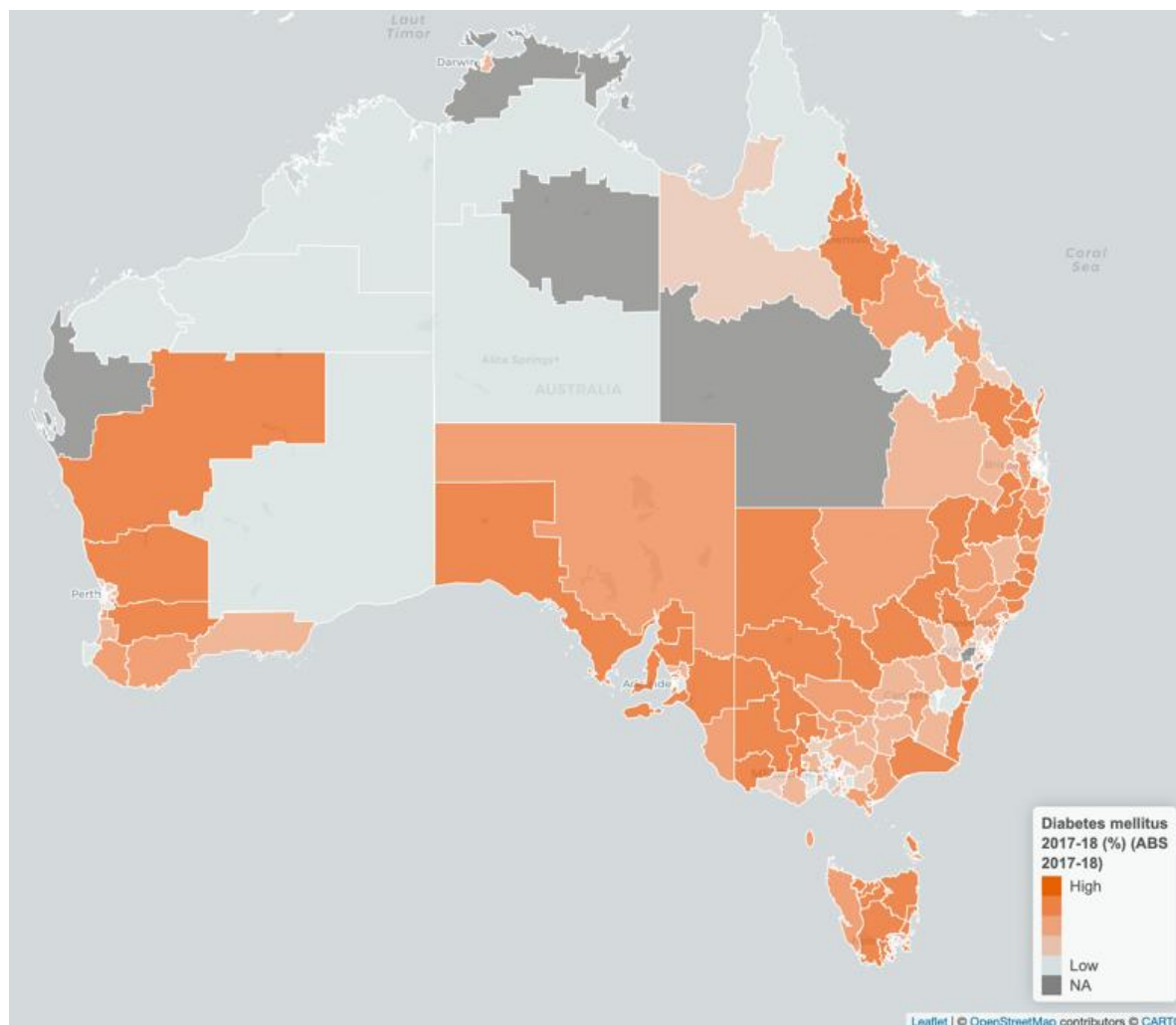


Fig. S1. Diabetes prevalence rates by quintile for 2017-2018 by SA3, with grey areas showing areas with no data available.
